What you need:

Method:

Step 1 - Fill the bath with water but make sure it's not too hot or too cold.

Step 2 - While the water is running add the bubbles.

Step 3 - Slowly and carefully put your mammoth in the bath if this is too hard try using a heavy duty crane.

Step 4 - Start scrubbing firmly so that his thick, brown fur is all frothed up.

Step 5 - Wash inside his gunky ears.

Step 6 - Now scrub ~~hard~~ under his chin because under there, is lots of muck and dirt.

Step 7 - Squirt shampoo on top of his head, and choose your style! (See our top tips.)

Step 8 - Rinse out the shampoo and before that ask him to close his eyes.
